SUMMARY

This Item asks the City Council to waive the reading in full of all Ordinances on the Agenda (if any) and approve their reading by title only. The purpose of this Item is to help streamline the City Council meeting process, to avoid unnecessary delay and to allow more time for substantive discussion of Items on the agenda.

State law requires that all Ordinances be read in full either at the time of introduction or at the time of passage, unless a motion waiving further reading is adopted by a majority of the City Council. (Gov. Code, § 36934). This means that each word in each Ordinance would have to be read aloud unless such reading is waived. Such reading could substantially delay the meeting and limit the time available for discussion of substantive Items. Adoption of this waiver streamlines the procedure for adopting the Ordinances on tonight's Agenda (if any), because it allows the City Council to approve Ordinances by reading aloud only the title of the Ordinance instead of reading aloud every word of the Ordinance.

The procedures for adopting Resolutions are not as strict as the procedures for adopting Ordinances. For example, Resolutions do not require two readings for passage, need not be read in full or even by title, are effective immediately unless otherwise specified, do not need to be in any particular format unless expressly required, and, with the exception of fixing tax rates or revenue amounts, do not require publication. However, like Ordinances, all Resolutions require a recorded majority vote of the total membership of the City Council. (Gov. Code § 36936).

SUMMARY

On August 23, 2023, the City Council provided direction regarding prohibiting the parking of vehicles on the west side of newly developed Marrokal Lane. The subject section of Marrokal Lane extends from Arminda Circle to Prospect Avenue and is currently under two conditions:

- 1. Segment 1 between Arminda Circle (south) and the south end of the Meng Development: built and expected to be accepted by City in a few months.
- 2. Segment 2 between the south end of the Meng Development and Prospect Avenue: Prospect Estate II private and being developed.

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, a local authority may by resolution restrict parking of vehicles on certain streets or highways, or portions thereof, during all or certain hours of the day. This item implements the direction provided by City Council on August 23, 2023 through the adoption of a resolution in accordance with Section 22507.

Staff recommends installing "No Parking" signs that prohibit parking on the west side of Marrokal Lane, as shown on the attached map. The sign installation will take two phases: 1): section 1: after the Meng Development is accepted by the City in the near future; 2) section 2: after the Prospect Estate II project is built and accepted by the City. If City Council approves the resolution, staff will coordinate the installation of the signs prior to occupancy and subject to developer consent.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT



Staff estimates the total cost to purchase and install the "No Parking" signs will be \$1,350.00. Funding for the installation is included in the adopted fiscal year 2023-24 Gas Tax Fund operating budget.

SUMMARY

This item requests City Council appropriation of funds for the potential future purchase and placement of a prefabricated ("manufactured") building and apparatus storage bay at the Public Services Division (PSD) Operations Yard. If constructed, these facilities will be utilized as a temporary fire station to improve response times to the southwest portion of the city and assist with decreasing Unit Hour Utilization (UHU) times for the Paramedic Ambulance Unit referred to as Medic 4. This items only addresses the appropriation of funds; future agenda items will present the actual project for City Council consideration and approval, including the purchase of the building and storage bay, and construction costs to install and make the facilities operational.

On March 22, 2023, the City Council received the findings and recommendations of the Community Risk Assessment and Long-Range Master Plan prepared by AP Triton, LLC. Among other findings, the Report identified both the response time deficiencies in the southwest and northern portions of the City. To address existing response time deficiencies, and a cautionary UHU for Medic 4, staff recommends that the Council considering installing a temporary fire station at the PSD Operations Yard. The addition of this temporary third station would not only provide improved coverage for the southwest portion of the City, but also will provide improved response times to locations with high fire hazard threat and emergency medical response call volume. This item would appropriate funds for this potential project. Future agenda items will permit the Council to consider the approval of the actual project.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The proposed allocation of funds involves a fiscal activity of government and is not a project subject to CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15378. Any future purchase or construction of facilities would be subject to review under CEQA at that time.



FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The total cost for this proposal is approximately \$1,000,000. This project is currently unfunded. The funding proposal for this project includes the following sources:

\$500,000 from Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Fund Reserves – The utilization of these funds is deemed consistent with the services provided by SLEMSA.

\$300,000 from American Rescue Plan (ARPA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) Funds – The city currently has \$952,940 encumbered in ARPA funds designated as the cost share match for the proposed FEMA HMGP. The City of Santee will continue to commit appropriate grant match funds required by the HMGP.

\$200,000 from American Rescue Plan (ARPA) Homelessness Regional Support – The re-allocation of \$200,000 towards the construction of a temporary fire station will not have a negative impact on current and/or proposed programs.

Background


On March 22, 2023, AP Triton, LLC delivered an informational presentation to the Santee City Council related to the current system delivery deficiencies of the fire department. The presentation included a comprehensive analysis of fire department policies and practices, a community risk assessment, and recommendations for future delivery models and actions for service delivery improvements. The report from AP Triton, LLC, included 27 recommendations that included the need for fire department infrastructure investments to improve response times and better serve the needs of the community. The Community Risk Assessment and Long-Range Master Plan also reported that the Unit-Hour Utilization (UHU) of both paramedic ambulances in Santee are at cautionary levels. The UHU for Medic 4 (M4) was reported at 39.4% and Medic 5 (M5) was reported at 30%. These numbers represent the percentage of time that the medic unit is assigned to an emergency response, and do not include travel time returning from the hospital after a transport. The threshold for cautionary UHU status for paramedic units is 30%. This report also indicated that 70% of calls for service occur between 8 am and 8 pm.

Following direction from the City Council, on April 26, 2023, the Fire Chief presented an update on the progress, and plan for implementation, related to the recommendations from the Community Risk Assessment and Long-Range Master Plan. The presentation identified response time deficiencies in the northern and southern portions of the City of Santee due to a lack of options for apparatus and personnel placement (*Map 1*). The presentation also included potential future fire station locations to address the response time gaps within the city. While it was acknowledged that the identified locations were not optimal for addressing the response time desires, the locations presented were the best available options based upon: A) Property ownership by the City of Santee; B) Property lot size adequate to support a fire station; and C) Property proximity to response needs based upon existing call volume density. The potential future fire station locations, identified as the Operations Yard and City Hall complex, are displayed in *Map 2*.


With the adoption of the FY 2024-28 Capital Improvement Program Budget, \$1,100,000 was appropriated for the design of a third fire station and fleet maintenance facility in the city to be constructed at the Operations Yard location. While the anticipated award date for the design project is scheduled for November 8, 2023, the construction costs for this capital project (approximately \$14,0000,000) are currently unfunded. Furthermore, with the anticipated design phase estimated between 12-18-months, and the anticipated construction timeline estimated to be a similar timeline, the realistic date best case scenario for a date of operation is projected to be 2.5 to 3 years from this date.

Currently, between the two existing fire stations in the City of Santee, no additional bed space or apparatus storage space exists. This point is germane to this report as it illustrates a lack of alternative resource deployment options for the Santee Fire Department. Additionally, as stated in the AP Triton report, the fire department is exacerbating wear and tear concerns on both fire stations due to exceeding their intended staffing and resource storage levels.

Recommendation

To address existing response time deficiencies, and a cautionary UHU for Medic 4, staff recommends that the Council considering installing a temporary fire station at the PSD Operations Yard. Future agenda items will permit the Council to consider the approval of the actual project.

The construction of a temporary fire station will address the following needs:

- Improvement of response times to the southern portion of the city
- Improvement of response times to identified high fire hazard activity, and threat potential, throughout the San Diego River corridor and Forrester Creek corridor.
- Improvement of 10-minute response time compliance for Medic 5 within the Santee-Lakeside Emergency Medical Services Authority (SLEMSA) boundaries
- Decrease of cautionary UHU levels for Medic 4
- Increase the longevity of Fire Station 5 through decreasing "wear and tear" on the station.

The temporary fire station will be located in the northeastern corner of the Operations Yard (*Map 3*). The facility, consisting of living quarters and apparatus storage, will be positioned to ensure no detrimental impact to PSD operations nor permanent fire station construction.

Financial Impact

The total cost for this proposal is approximately \$1,000,000. The cost projections are provided below.

Temporary Fire Station Cost Estimates:

Manufactured Home: \$245,000 *Apparatus Bay: \$340,000 Furnishings & Equipment \$100,000 Generator: \$60.000 Utility Hookups: \$70.000 Padre Capacity Fees: \$35,000 Site Prep: \$100,000 Contingency \$50,000

Total Cost: \$1,000,000

This project is currently unfunded. The funding proposal for this project includes the following sources:

\$500,000 from EMS Fund Excess Reserves – The utilization of these funds is deemed consistent with the services provided by SLEMSA. The SLEMSA Commission discussed the potential of excess reserve funds being appropriated for infrastructure needs that are directly associated with ambulance services.

\$300,000 from American Rescue Plan (ARPA) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) Funds – The city currently has \$952,940 encumbered in ARPA funds designated as the cost share match for the proposed FEMA HMGP. This grant proposal will fund hazardous fuels reduction and defensible space construction along the San Diego River corridor. The City of Santee is awaiting a final decision from FEMA on the grant sub-application. The \$300,000 reallocated from this program will be replaced by General Funds or In-Kind Services if the grant application is successful and the funding is deemed necessary. The City of Santee will continue our commitment to the grant match funds required by the HMGP. The re-allocation of ARPA funds will allow the city to appropriate and spend these funds in a more timely manner in line with the grant requirements.

\$200,000 from American Rescue Plan (ARPA) Homelessness Regional Support – The City of Santee is currently engaged in a variety of programs to address homelessness in the city. The city had originally appropriated \$922,949 towards these efforts, including the potential of regional collaboration. At this time, the current appropriated funds exceed the existing program needs for the city. The re-allocation of \$200,000 towards the construction of a temporary fire station will not have a negative impact on current and/or proposed programs. The re-allocation of ARPA funds will allow the city to appropriate and spend these funds without losing the funding.

Upon the completion of construction of the permanent fire station at the Operations Yard, the temporary fire station facilities may be re-located to a new site for an additional cost-benefit value to the City of Santee.
