SUMMARY

The 2024 United States Olympic Team Selection Event for the Marathon Race Walk Mixed Relay and World Athletics Race Walking Tour Silver Label Event will take place on Sunday, January 21, 2024, on Town Center Parkway and Riverview Parkway behind Santee Trolley Square.

Some of the elite athletes competing will qualify for the U.S. Olympic Team in Paris, France, August 1 through 11, 2024.

Santee has supported the sport of race walking by hosting the 2009, 2014, 2015, 2017, 2018, and 2019 USA Track & Field National 50km Race Walking Championships, the 2021, 2022 and 2023 USA Track & Field National 35km Race Walk Championships, and the 2012, 2016 and 2020 U.S. Olympic Team Trials for the 50km race walk.

It is an honor for the City of Santee to host an Olympic Team Selection for the fourth time. Thank you to everyone who makes this event possible so that athletes can represent their country in the Olympic Games, one of life's great honors and achievements.

ITEM TITLE APPROVAL OF READING BY TITLE ONLY AND WAIVER OF READING IN FULL OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS ON THE AGENDA

SUMMARY

This Item asks the City Council to waive the reading in full of all Ordinances on the Agenda (if any) and approve their reading by title only. The purpose of this Item is to help streamline the City Council meeting process, to avoid unnecessary delay and to allow more time for substantive discussion of Items on the agenda.

State law requires that all Ordinances be read in full either at the time of introduction or at the time of passage, unless a motion waiving further reading is adopted by a majority of the City Council. (Gov. Code, § 36934). This means that each word in each Ordinance would have to be read aloud unless such reading is waived. Such reading could substantially delay the meeting and limit the time available for discussion of substantive Items. Adoption of this waiver streamlines the procedure for adopting the Ordinances on tonight's Agenda (if any), because it allows the City Council to approve Ordinances by reading aloud only the title of the Ordinance instead of reading aloud every word of the Ordinance.

The procedures for adopting Resolutions are not as strict as the procedures for adopting Ordinances. For example, Resolutions do not require two readings for passage, need not be read in full or even by title, are effective immediately unless otherwise specified, do not need to be in any particular format unless expressly required, and, with the exception of fixing tax rates or revenue amounts, do not require publication. However, like Ordinances, all Resolutions require a recorded majority vote of the total membership of the City Council. (Gov. Code § 36936).

SUMMARY

On December 29, 2011, the California Supreme Court issued its decision in the case of *California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos*, which addressed the constitutionality of Assembly Bills 1x26 and 1x27 ("AB 26" and "AB 27"). In accordance with this decision, all redevelopment agencies in the state of California were dissolved effective February 1, 2012. On January 11, 2012 the City Council elected to become the Successor Agency to the Santee Community Development Commission ("CDC"). As the Successor Agency, the City has certain administrative and other responsibilities for the winding down of redevelopment activities.

One such requirement is the preparation of Recognized Obligation Payment Schedules ("ROPS"). The ROPS lists all of the "enforceable obligations" of the CDC Successor Agency, the amounts and due dates of payments required for each enforceable obligation and the source of funding for each required payment. The attached resolution adopts the ROPS covering the period from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 ("ROPS 24-25"). The primary enforceable obligation reflected on ROPS 24-25 is debt service on the CDC Successor Agency Tax Allocation Refunding Bonds 2016 Series A.

The Countywide Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board will meet on January 18, 2024 to review and approve the ROPS and administrative expense budget in order to meet the February 1, 2024 filing deadline with the County Auditor-Controller, State Controller's Office and the State Department of Finance.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Adoption of the attached resolution along with the January 18, 2024 approval by the Countywide Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board will provide for the receipt and expenditure of \$3,345,337 in redevelopment property tax trust fund ("RPTTF") revenue in order to satisfy the enforceable obligations listed on the ROPS 24-25 for fiscal year 2024-25.

DIRECTOR/DEPARTMENT Justin Matsushita, Fire Chief

SUMMARY

On January 1, 2023, the Santee-Lakeside Emergency Medical Services Authority (SLEMSA) assumed operational and administrative control of prehospital ambulance delivery services in place of the now-dissolved County Service Area 69 (CSA 69). Throughout 2023, service changes were made to better serve the citizens residing in the SLEMSA service area. These changes included the hiring of a full-time Nurse Coordinator in March, the addition of a 12-hour Basic Life Support (BLS) transport ambulance staffed by the Lakeside Fire Protection District (LFPD) in May, and the addition of a 12-hour BLS transport ambulance staffed by the Santee Fire Department (SFD) in June. Additionally, the medical aid response plans for the SLEMSA service area were modified in August to dispatch a SLEMSA BLS ambulance when available in place of an Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulance for Alpha and Omega level calls.

These service changes have reduced the Unit Hour Utilization (UHU) of the (4) four existing SLEMSA ALS ambulances and reduced the reliance on outside mutual aid ambulances to transport patients from within the SLEMSA service area. Despite these improvements, the UHU for Medic 4 (M4) remains at a cautionary level per the Community Risk and Long-Range Master Plan report that was presented to the Santee City Council on March 22, 2023.

Staff is seeking authorization to implement a (4) four-month trial in conjunction with the LFPD to add an additional 12-hour BLS transport unit for the SLEMSA service area. During this trial period, staff will continue to monitor the UHU of all SLEMSA ambulances, the reliance on mutual aid ambulances into the SLEMSA service area, and the response time compliance for ambulances dispatched to medical aid calls within the SLEMSA service area. With the approval of the City Council, Santee will be operating an additional 12-hour BLS transport ambulance with a target start date **on or before January 15, 2024**. Based upon the ambulance staffing model and the decision to implement this trial with part-time EMTs, the Santee Fire Department will need to add four additional part-time non-safety EMTs to ensure continuous staffing.





CITY OF SANTEE COUNCIL AGENDA STATEMENT

The personnel cost to staff this additional 12-hour BLS ambulance will be split evenly with the LFPD. The City of Santee's share of the staffing cost for this four-month trial is \$34,000. The uniform costs to add four part-time EMTs is \$3,000, and the cost to train these new employees is \$6,784. The total cost to the City of Santee to add four additional part-time EMTs and implement a four-month trial period of an additional 12-hour BLS ambulance is approximately \$43,784. All funding for this trial program will be funded through SLEMSA budget accounts.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The addition of a 12-hour BLS transport ambulance for a (4) four-month trial, and the funding for four (4) part-time EMTs is not a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), as it involves an administrative activity of government as well as the establishment of a fiscal activity that will not result in a significant effect on the environment. (State CEQA Guidelines § 15378.)

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Funding in the amount of \$43,784 will be appropriated to the Emergency Medical Services Division of the City of Santee Fire Department's FY 2023-24 Operating Budget from the Emergency Medical Services Fund reserves.

WHEREAS, a (4) four-month implementation of an additional 12-hour BLS transport unit for the SLEMSA service area in conjunction with the LFPD will enable staff to monitor the UHU of all SLEMSA ambulances, the reliance on mutual aid ambulances into the SLEMSA service area, and the response time compliance for ambulances dispatched to medical aid calls to determine the most effective staffing model; and

WHEREAS, Santee will be operating an additional 12-hour BLS transport ambulance with a target start date on or before January 15, 2024, staffed by part-time Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs). The staffing model requires that an additional (4) four part-time non-safety EMTs be hired to ensure continuous staffing; and

WHEREAS, The personnel cost to staff this 12-hour BLS ambulance will be split evenly with the LFPD, and the City of Santee's share of the staffing cost for this fourmonth trial is \$34,000. SUMMARY

The San Diego Regional Fire Foundation (SDRFF) is a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Organization committed to supporting emergency responders throughout the County of San Diego. The mission of the SDRFF *"is to make San Diego the safest county in the nation."* The SDRFF is currently accepting applications for the 2024 Wildfire Equipment & Vehicle Grant Program. Eligibility to apply for this specific grant is through invitation only and based upon local fire hazard threat and proximity to the San Diego River. The City of Santee began tracking fires in the San Diego River and Forester Creek areas in September 2020. From September 2020 through December 2023, there have been 323 fire responses in this identified Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) area of the city. Wildfires remain one of the most significant threats to life in property in the City of Santee.

Currently, the Santee Fire Department has one Type-3 Engine available for wildland fire responses. The addition of a second Type-3 Engine, which will be located at Fire Station 5, will allow for enhanced response capabilities for wildland fire responses. Additionally, due to the California Master Mutual Aid Agreement, Santee's only Type-3 Engine is often deployed outside of city and county limits. This commitment to assisting agencies throughout the State of California leaves the City of Santee without this vital resource when deployed. A second Type-3 Engine will allow for greater redundancy in response capabilities during fire season and out-of-service status due to necessary repairs.

The current projected timeline for the construction and delivery of a new Type-3 Engine is twothree years.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The 35% grant match for the City of Santee is \$219,862. The SDRFF will provide 65% of the funding in the amount of \$408,315. The total purchase price of the apparatus is \$628,177. In order to reach the grant match amount of \$219,862, funding (General Fund) in the amount of \$113,750 is currently available in the adopted Capital Improvement Program budgeted for the Fire Infrastructure - Phase 1B, Fleet Maintenance Facility project. And funding (General Fund) in the amount of \$65,563 is currently available in the Santee Fire Department Emergency Operations Operating budget. The combination of these two funding sources and \$40,549 from the General Fund Reserves would make up the amount needed for the grant match. These funds would be transferred to the Vehicle Replacement Fund.

ITEM TITLE REPORT ON NEW LAWS ENACTED IN 2023 RELEVANT TO SANTEE

SUMMARY

2023 was another busy year for the California Legislature, particularly in the area of housing legislation. The Legislature passed and sent to the Governor more than 50 new bills addressing housing issues. In addition, the Legislature passed and the Governor signed several new laws that will affect Santee in the areas of community services, elections, governance, finance, transparency and public safety. As in past years, the general trend in most of these new laws continues to be less local control and more State mandates. However, the new laws in 2023 were less comprehensive in nature than in past years and should not result in major new changes to City operations.

The City Attorney will provide a brief presentation highlighting some of the key new laws. A short summary of selected new laws is attached.

Summary of Selected New Laws Relevant to Santee

- 1. Housing, Land Development and Permits
- AB 976 (Ting) Accessory Dwelling Units This measure eliminates the ability of local agencies to impose owneroccupancy requirement on any ADUs, regardless of when they were permitted.
- AB 1033 (Ting) Accessory Dwelling Units This measure allows local agencies to adopt ordinances permitting the separate sale or conveyance of primary dwelling units and ADUs as condominiums.
- AB 1332 (Carrillo) Accessory Dwelling Units This measure requires every local agency to establish a program for the preapproval of ADU plans by January 1, 2025. The measure also limits the bases for approval or denial of ADUs to established standards.
- SB 423 (Wiener) Streamlined Housing Approvals This measure modifies and expands SB 35 to allow certain multifamily housing developments to take advantage of a streamlined, ministerial approval process and makes other changes to SB 35. Notably, it extends the sunset date for SB 35 from January 1, 2026 to January 1, 2036.
- SB 684 (Caballero) Streamlined Approval Processes for Certain Developments

This measure streamlines the approval process for housing development projects of 10 or fewer residential units on urban lots under five acres. It mandates a ministerial approval process for such projects, limits review to specific criteria and imposes time limits on processing of such projects.

 SB 4 (Wiener) Housing Development on Land Owned by Higher Education or Religious Institutions
 This measure requires that a housing development project be a use by right on any land owned by an independent institution of higher education or religious institution if the development satisfies specific criteria. • SB 713 (Padilla) Density Bonuses

This measure broadens the definition of "development standard" to include standards adopted by local governments or enacted by the local electorate through local initiatives or referendum, regardless of the source of their power.

- AB 1287 (Alvarez) Density Bonuses This measure redefines "maximum allowable residential density" as the greatest number of units allowed under local zoning ordinances, specific plans, or general plan land use element allows for a housing development project, and requires additional density bonuses when certain conditions are met.
- AB 1633 (Ting) Housing Accountability Act and CEQA This measure amends the Housing Accountability Act to expand the definition of prohibited disapproves of a housing development project to cover certain actions a local agency may take under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- AB 1449 (Alvarez) Affordable Housing and CEQA This measure establishes exemptions from CEQA for specific actions related to affordable housing projects until January 1, 2033.
- AB 1490 (Lee) Affordable Housing and Adaptive Reuse This measure make 100% affordable housing projects that adaptively reuse existing residential buildings an allowable use, regardless of any inconsistences between the project and any local plans, zoning, or regulations, and limits local governments from imposing maximum density or floor area ratio requirements, and any requirement to add additional parking or open space.
- SB 676 (Allen) Drought-Tolerant Landscaping This measure prohibits a city from enacting or enforcing any ordinance or regulation that prohibits the installation of drought-tolerant landscaping using living plant material (not artificial turf) on residential property.
- AB 894 (Friedman) Shared Parking This measure requires local agencies to permit entities with underutilized parking spaces to share them with the public, local agencies, or other entities, provided they submit a shared parking agreement and demonstrate the benefits of such an arrangement.

- AB 965 (Carrillo) Broadband Permit Applications This measure requires a local agency to undertake batch broadband permit processing, upon receiving two or more broadband permit applications that are substantially similar broadband project sites and that are submitted at the same time by the same applicant.
- AB 1132 (Friedman) Solar Energy Systems and Permit Fees This measure extends the repeal date from January 1, 2025 to January 1, 2034 on current law that prescribes and limits permit fees that a city may charge for a residential or commercial solar energy system.

2. Community Services

- SB 35 (Umberg) Community Assistance, Recovery, and Empowerment (CARE) Court Program
 This measure includes several changes to the CARE Court
 Program. Changes include defining who may hear CARE Court petitions, fees, procedures and availability of health information.
- SB 326 (Eggman) Behavioral Health Services Act This measure modernizes the Health Services Act to include treatment for people with substance use disorder and care for the most seriously mentally ill. It also prioritizes investments in housing interventions for individuals experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness.
- SB 43 (Eggman) Behavioral Health This measure modernizes the definition of gravely disabled within the Lanterman Petris-Short Act to include conditions in which individuals experience an inability to provide for their personal safety or necessary medical care as a result of severe substance use disorder or co-occurring disorder.
- AB 1467 (Alanis) Navaeh Your Sports Safety Act This measure requires a youth sports organization that elects to offer an athletic program to ensure that its athletes have access to an automated external defibrillator (AED) during any official practice or match starting January 1, 2027.

- SB 806 (Archuleta) Reflective Markings on Trash Receptacles This measure requires any trash receptacle or storage container placed on a roadway or curb to be emptied or picked up to include reflectors on each side.
- AB 1572 (Friedman) Potable Water and Nonfunctional Turf This measure prohibits the use of potable water to irrigate nonfunctional turf on commercial, municipal, institutional, and multifamily residential properties as of January 1, 2027.
- 3. Elections, Governance, Finance and Transparency
- AB 63 (Cervantes) Posting of Election Information This measures requires local elections officials to post updated information regarding the election on a website at least once per week during the period after the election but before the submission of the certified statement of results.
- AB 421 (Bryan) State Referendum Measures This measure requires that voters in a state referendum be asked to choose between the options "Keep the law" or "Overturn the law" rather than being asked to vote "Yes" or "No".
- SB 386 (Newman) Elections

This measure extends the signature verification period within which the election officials must complete their determinations of the number of qualified signatures, and also requires a city election official to publish a public notice with specified city election information no later than three days before the deadline for nomination papers.

• AB 764 (Bryan) Redistricting

This measure revises and recasts existing law related to local redistricting, including mandating compliance with specified criteria for adopting district boundaries.

• AB 557 (Hart) Open Meeting and Teleconferences This measure eliminates the sunset date on provisions of law allowing local agencies to use teleconferencing during a proclaimed state of emergency.

- AB 1637 (Irwin) City Domain Names This measure requires cities no later than January 1, 2029 to use a ".gov" top-level domain or a ".ca.gov" second-level domain.
- SB 329 (Dodd) City Council Compensation This measure allows general law cities to adjust council member salaries for inflation.
- AB 516 (Ramos) Mitigation Fee Act The measure amends the Mitigation Fee Act by requiring local agencies to provide annual reports on development fees, including details on public improvement projects, any delays, and refund recipients. The measure also expends the scope of fee audits and requires local agencies to inform fee payers of their audit rights.
- SB 748 (Roth) ADA and Business Licenses This measure requires a city to provide a business license applicant with a statement about the applicant's legal obligation under state and federal disability access laws and information on obtaining a Certified Access Specialist inspection.
- AB 783 (Ting) Single-User Restrooms and Business Licenses This measure requires a city that issues business licenses to provide written notice to each applicant of the requirement that all single-user toilet facilities in any business be identified as all-gender facilities.
- 4. Public Safety
- SB 428 (Blakespear) TROs This measure authorizes any employer to seek a temporary restraining order on behalf of its employee(s).
- AB 781 (Maienschein) Emergency Shelters and Person with Pets This measure requires cities with adopted emergency plans to update their plans to designate at least one emergency shelter and cooling or warming center to accommodate household pets.
- AB 40 (Rodriguez) Emergency Medical Services This measure requires every local emergency medical services agency to develop by July 1, 2024 a standard not to exceed 30 minutes, 90% of the

time, for ambulance patient offload times. The measures also requires reporting and the development of an audit tool to improve data accuracy.

 AB 1638 (Fong) Emergency Response Services and Languages other than English This measure requires, starting January 1, 2025, that local agencies provide information related to emergencies in all languages spoken by 5% or more of the population whenever those same people also speak English less than

"very well".

- SB 602 (Archuleta) Trespass This measure extends the timeframe for letters of agency between peace officers and absentee property owners from 30 days to 12 months and the operative timeframe of tress authorization letters from 12 months to three years.
- AB 42 (Ramos) Fire Sprinklers and Tiny Homes This measure prohibits local agencies from requiring fire sprinklers in temporary sleeping cabins on sites with 50 or fewer cabins until January 1, 2027.
- AB 70 (Rodriguez) Emergency Response and Trauma Kits This measure requires the acquisition and placement of at least six trauma kits at certain structures that are constructed prior to January 1, 2024 and subject to subsequent modifications, renovations or tenant improvements.
