ITEM TITLE APPROVAL OF READING BY TITLE ONLY AND WAIVER OF READING IN FULL OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS ON THE AGENDA

SUMMARY

This Item asks the City Council to waive the reading in full of all Ordinances on the Agenda (if any) and approve their reading by title only. The purpose of this Item is to help streamline the City Council meeting process, to avoid unnecessary delay and to allow more time for substantive discussion of Items on the agenda.

State law requires that all Ordinances be read in full either at the time of introduction or at the time of passage, unless a motion waiving further reading is adopted by a majority of the City Council. (Gov. Code, § 36934). This means that each word in each Ordinance would have to be read aloud unless such reading is waived. Such reading could substantially delay the meeting and limit the time available for discussion of substantive Items. Adoption of this waiver streamlines the procedure for adopting the Ordinances on tonight's Agenda (if any), because it allows the City Council to approve Ordinances by reading aloud only the title of the Ordinance instead of reading aloud every word of the Ordinance.

The procedures for adopting Resolutions are not as strict as the procedures for adopting Ordinances. For example, Resolutions do not require two readings for passage, need not be read in full or even by title, are effective immediately unless otherwise specified, do not need to be in any particular format unless expressly required, and, with the exception of fixing tax rates or revenue amounts, do not require publication. However, like Ordinances, all Resolutions require a recorded majority vote of the total membership of the City Council. (Gov. Code § 36936).

ITEM TITLE PURCHASE OF ONE NEW X SERIES EKG MONITOR/DEFIBRILLATOR AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FROM ZOLL MEDICAL CORPORATION

DIRECTOR/DEPARTMENT Justin Matsushita, Fire Chief



SUMMARY

This item requests authorization to purchase the following items: One (1) X Series EKG monitor/defibrillator with necessary associated accessories, one (1) additional six-hour rechargeable smart battery, and other related equipment and supplies. All items will be purchased from Zoll Medical Corporation ("Zoll") for the Fire Department to replace older technology equipment currently in service on ambulances and first-responder apparatus.

Santee Municipal Code Section 3.24.120 authorizes the City to dispense with the requirements of formal or informal bidding and procure supplies, materials, and equipment on the open market when a commodity is not for a public work as defined in Public Contract Code section 20161, must match or be compatible with other supplies, equipment or material presently used and will be purchased from an authorized manufacturer or authorized retailer. Over the past several years, both Santee and the Lakeside Fire Protection District have been transitioning their EKG monitors/defibrillators to Zoll as the standard EKG monitor/defibrillator to be used by the two Santee-Lakeside Emergency Medical Services Authority (SLEMSA) agencies. Additionally, the League of Oregon Cities, in cooperation with National Purchasing Partners, LLC, dba NPPGov (of which the City is a member agency), issued Request for Proposals No. 1935 for the procurement of a wide variety of public safety medical supplies. equipment and monitors. Based on evaluation criteria including pricing, breadth and quality of products, customer support and ability to meet delivery timelines, Zoll was awarded Contract #PS20200 for an initial three-year term through March 25, 2023. This contract has been extended through July 23, 2025.

Staff recommends that the EKG monitor/defibrillator, EKG battery and other related equipment and supplies be purchased from Zoll pursuant to NPPGov Contract #PS20200 for an amount not to exceed \$55,601.39.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Adequate funding for this purchase is included in the FY 2024-25 Emergency Medical Services (SLEMSA) adopted budget.

SUMMARY

This item requests authorization to proceed with a professional services agreement with On Duty Health, PLLC, for annual firefighter health and fitness assessments.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Santee and the Santee Firefighters' Association was adopted by the City Council of the City of Santee on August 23, 2023, and is effective over the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025. Medical Testing and Firefighter Wellness are addressed in Chapter 14, Section 1.1 of the MOU, stating: "In addition to maintaining the current contract vendor for medical testing, the City shall also support, and fund, a second vendor for physicals and medical testing as mutually agreed upon by the City and the Association, referred to as the Firefighter Wellness Pilot Program." The second vendor selected by the Santee Firefighters' Association to provide physicals and medical testing is On Duty Health, PLLC.

Santee Purchasing Ordinance requires City Council approval of all professional service agreements exceeding \$25,000 in any single fiscal year. The total cost for health and fitness assessments during FY 24/25 will be an amount not to exceed \$48,906.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Funding for firefighter health and fitness assessments is included in the FY 2024-25 Fire Department Operating Budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The firefighter health and fitness assessments do not have the potential to result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and are therefore not a "project" subject to the California Environmental Quality Act. ITEM TITLE REJECTION OF CLAIM AGAINST THE CITY BY LESLIE JELLISON AND ACCEPTANCE OF CLAIM AGAINST THE CITY BY CHRISTINE HAMILTON

SUMMARY

A claim was filed against the City of Santee by Leslie Jellison on July 3, 2024, for injuries sustained in an alleged vehicle vs. pedestrian collision that reportedly occurred on January 5, 2024. The incident allegedly took place in a parking lot, located at 8876 Cuyamaca St., Santee, CA 92071.

The City's claims administrator (George Hills) reviewed and researched this claim and advised that no City liability exists. The reported incident location is private property, and did not involve any City vehicles, staff or property. Staff recommends that the City Council reject this claim.

A claim was filed against the City of Santee by Christine Hamilton on June 28, 2024, for damage to her vehicle on June 24, 2024, when a City of Santee banner flag and assembly (pole), fell and struck her vehicle. It occurred on Cuyamaca St. as the claimant was driving into the shopping center driveway near Discount Tires at Cuyamaca St. and Mission Gorge Rd. The flagpole belongs to the City, is made of cast aluminum, weighing approximately 1.5 pounds. Falling from a height of 15 feet, it was found to be plausible that it could dent a vehicle's roof. Photographs were taken, and City staff visited the site.

The City's claims administrator (George Hills) reviewed and researched this claim, working with Santee Public Works staff. Risk Management was advised the City is liable for the damage and reasonable repair costs.

Acceptable quotes were submitted by the claimant. A payment receipt for repair from Santee Collision Center was submitted for \$2,479.00 and an additional \$370.00 may be reimbursed for the nine days of rental car use while the vehicle was being repaired. The total cost is \$2,849.00. Staff recommends that the City Council accept this claim.

Claim documents are on file in the Office of the City Clerk for Council reference.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT



There is no financial impact to the City by rejection of a claim (Jellison). The cost to the City for one claim, if accepted by the City Council, is \$2,849.00 (Hamilton).
